EDUCATIONAL NOTICE

ADMISSION INTO THE 1ST YEAR DIPLOMA IN MEDICINE AND RURAL HEALTH
CARE (DMRHC) COURSE FOR THE SESSION 2013,

Applications are invited from the candidates seeking admission into the 3 (three) years Course of Diploma in Medicine and Rural Health Care (DMRHC) in the Medical Institute, Jorhat for the session 2013 in the prescribed form to be obtained from the Principals of three Medical Colleges of Assam, i.e. Gauhati Medical College, Guwahati; Assam Medical College, Dibrugarh; Silchar Medical College, Silchar and Principal, Medical Institute, Jorhat on payment of Rs.50/- (Rupees Fifty) only which is to be paid by Treasury Challan under the Head of Account “0210-M&PH-03-MET&R-105-Allopathy” from 05/07/2013 to 15/07/2013 during office hours.

1. **Eligibility for Application :** To be eligible for applying to the course a candidate must fulfill the following conditions:
 - (a) Duly passed HSSLC or its equivalent examination in science stream **in the same sitting with English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology without grace marks** in each of these four subjects and must obtain not less than 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology (PCB) at the qualifying examination in case of the general category and 40% marks in case of SC/ST/OBC & MOBC candidates.
 - (b) Should be a citizen of India and a permanent resident of Assam and must belong to rural areas of the state specified in section 2 (l) of The Assam Rural Health Regulatory Authority Act-2004, i.e. Areas not included in a Municipal Corporation, Municipal Board, a Town Committee or any other area notified as urban area.
 - (c) Is not guilty of any misconduct and has not been convicted of any offence involving moral turpitude.
 - (d) Is not below 17 years of age and above 24 years of age on the day of 31st December, 2013 provided the maximum age limit is relaxable by 3 years in case of SC/ST/OBC/MOBC candidates.

2. Distribution of seats:

(i) There shall be 100 seats in the Institute for teaching the Diploma in Medicine and Rural Health Care Course. The reservation pattern of seats are as follows :

(a) For SC	-	7%	-	07
(b) For ST (P)	-	10%	-	10
(c) For ST (H)	-	5%	-	05
(d) For OBC/MOBC	-	15%	-	15
(e) TGL/Ex-TGL Students	-	4%	-	04
(f) Char Area	-	4%	-	04
(g) Moran Community	-	1%	-	01
(h) Mattak Community	-	1%	-	01

Total - 47 seats

(ii) For General Category - 53% - 53 seats

The general category seats will be distributed district -wise as per merit list of the districts – one seat for Kamrup (Metro) and two each for other districts.

(iii) There shall be 3% reservation for Physically Handicapped category as per “The Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act,1995”. Provided that these 3% reservations for Physically handicapped category is not a separate reservation over and above other reservations. If the disabled candidate belongs to reserved category such as SC/ST/OBC or General and any other category, he/she shall be adjusted against the category to which he/she belongs to.

3. Procedure of selection :

Selection of candidate shall be done strictly on merit basis. The merit shall be judged on the basis of the marks obtained by the candidates in Physics, Chemistry and Biology in the qualifying examination.

4. Following Documents duly attested by a Gazetted Officer are to be submitted along with the Application Form:

(a) Marks Sheet of the qualifying examination i.e. HS(Sc) or equivalent examination
(b) Admit card of HSLC or equivalent examination as proof of age, (c) Category/Caste Certificate if any; (d) Permanent Residential Certificate where Rural Area status must properly be indicated; (e) Copy of Treasury Challan of Rs.50.00 (Rupees fifty) only as mentioned above.

5. Last date of submission :

Completely filled up Application Form will have to be submitted to the office of the respective Principal from where the forms were collected on or before **25th July,2013**. The application received after last date of submission by post or by hand will not be acceptable.

N.B. :

(1) As defined in Assam Rural Health Regulatory Authority Act, 2004 the student after passing DMRHC Course shall not write “Doctor” or “Dr.” before and after his name and shall practice only in rural areas.

(2) Candidates of General category getting less than 50% in PCB in the same sitting and candidates of SC/ST/OBC/MOBC category getting less than 40% in PCB in the same sitting should not apply.
