**2nd COUNSELING FOR SELECTION OF CANDIDATES FOR ADMISSION INTO 1st YEAR
DIPLOMA IN PARA-MEDICAL COURSES IN THE INSTITUTE OF PARA-MEDICAL SCIENCES
ATTACHED TO 5(FIVE) MEDICAL COLLEGES & HOSPITALS OF ASSAM FOR THE SESSION 2016.**

This is for general information of all candidates who applied for admission into 1st year Diploma in Para-Medical courses in the institute of Para-Medical Sciences attached to 5(five) Medical Colleges & Hospitals of Assam for the session 2016 as per this Directorate Educational Notice No DME/P.Med/179/2016/11761, dated 18th Oct./2016 and No. Janasanyog/5390/16, that the 2nd counseling for selection of candidates of the said courses will be held on 8th & 9th February, 2017 as per programme given below.

Candidates must bring with them all original testimonials i.e. Marks sheets of 10+2 Exam, Admit Card of HSLC examination, Pass Certificates, PRC, Caste certificates and other relevant documents. Candidates applying under various reserved categories are required to produce the appropriate certificates/testimonials etc. in original issued by competent authority before the Selection Board. Separate Photo copies of the said documents will be required at the time of counseling. For TGL/Ex-TGL candidates the caste certificates must be issued by concerned DC or SDO and countersigned by Director, Tea Welfare, Govt. of Assam. For Char Area candidates the certificates must be issued by Char Area Development Authority and countersigned by concerned DC/SDO. Candidates for Un-Employed Family quota the certificate must be issued by the Local MLA.

The candidates who marked Un-Employed Family quota (UEFQ) as a reserved category at the time of submission of application form will only be considered for the said quota.

Those candidates who already got admitted in their respective course and institution as per the 1st counseling and are willing to change their course and institution, they must bring with them the necessary admission receipts, etc. at the time of 2nd counseling, failing of which their change in course and institution will not be allowed.

All candidates should appear personally for counseling on the scheduled dates and time. In case of any matter of controversy, the decision of the Selection Board shall be final and binding.


- (A) All candidates who had applied under Physically Handicapped quota.

Date of Counseling : 9th February, 2017

- (C) Candidates under Un-employed Family Quota category who secured within 67% to 58% Marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology (PCB) and who had marked Un-employed Family Quota (UEFQ) as a reserved category at the time of submission of application form.
(D) Candidates under OBC/MOBC category who secured within 67% to 64% Marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology (PCB).
(E) Candidates under SCHEDULED CASTE category who secured within 67% to 58% Marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology (PCB).
(F) Candidates under S.T.(P) category who secured within 67% to 54% Marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology (PCB).
(G) Candidates under S.T.(H) category who secured within 67% to 49% Marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology (PCB).
(H) Candidates under Char Area Quota category who secured within 67% to 61% Marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology (PCB).
(I) All Candidates under TGL/ Ex-TGL category who applied under this quota.
